

Tower Hamlets Walk-in Centre service is changing

St Andrews and Barkantine Centres

From 1 August 2018

The walk-in centres at St Andrews and the Barkantine is changing.

We're making some changes so it's quicker and easier for local people to get help and advice when they need it.



From 1 August 2018 you will not be able to 'walk in' to be seen.

You will need to be registered with a GP surgery in Tower Hamlets to get an appointment at St Andrews and Barkantine Centres.

To get an appointment, contact your local surgery or call **NHS 111.** The appointments will be with either an Advanced Nurse Practitioner, or a GP. If you aren't registered, you can find out where to register by going online to **www.nhs.uk/** and entering your postcode. You will also find lots of useful

information and advice on a range of common conditions and illnesses.

The St Andrews and Barkantine Centres will remain open daily from **8am-8pm**, 365 days a year

Please make sure you are on time for your appointment.

If you need to cancel your visit, please respond by replying to the text message you were sent to confirm your appointment.
